- The option vests over 5 years. Mr. Hardin can exercise the option as follows: 7,000 shares on 3/12/1997, 7,000 shares on 3/12/1998, 7,000 shares on 3/12/1999, 7,000 shares on 3/12/2000 and 7,000 shares on 3/12/2001.
